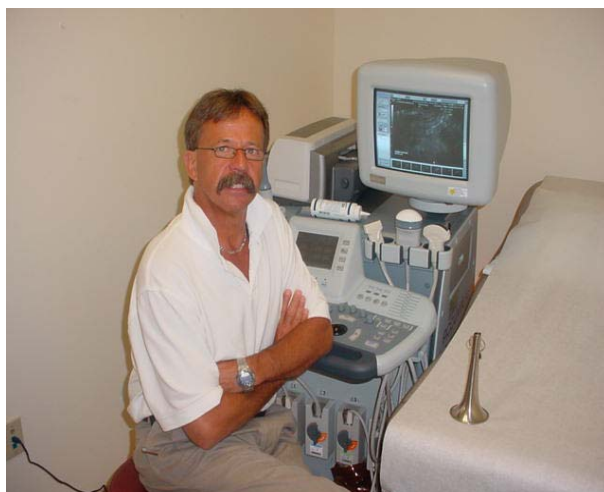
### SMH Acquires 3D Ultrasound Machine

Summersville Memorial Hospital has acquired a top of the line ultrasound machine to assist Dr. Rostocki, the newest member of the OB/GYN Staff, in evaluating and diagnosing problems in high risk pregnancies. The machine incorporates the most advanced broadband technology in imaging, and is in use at Dr. Rostocki's office. The ultrasound technicians, members of the Hospital's Radiology Department, assist in performing low risk scans in all patients of the Outpatient Clinic, presenting in pregnancy or with gynecological problems. These scans are performed at the time of prenatal visit, thus eliminating additional trips for ultrasounds in pregnancy.

Dr. Rostocki is a board-certified Obstetrician and Gynecologist, as well as a Certified Diagnostic Ultrasonographer. Even though not all high risk pregnancies can be delivered in Summersville – some will need to attend centers with intensive care nurseries our small Hospital does not have – most patients with complicated pregnancy are now able to have their prenatal care in Summersville. The equipment is capable of 3-D and 4-D imaging in diagnosing complex problems.

The Outpatient Department operates from Monday to Friday, with 24-hour week and weekend coverage for emergencies and deliveries.

### SMH TO INCREASE UPFRONT COLLECTION EFFORTS

Beginning September 1, 2006 SMH will increase our efforts to collect copays and deductibles at or before the time of service. Healthcare is the only service that one can receive service now and pay (or not pay) at some date in the future. Future dollars are often hard to collect. Healthcare across the nation is becoming very expensive. The best way to ensure that costs are controlled is to collect payment from all individuals who are able to pay. It is imperative that SMH capture payments as early as possible. Therefore, we are providing tools and education to our staff to assist them in making patients aware of what copays and deductible they are responsible for and remind them to bring cash, check, credit or debit cards at the time of their visit. As always, SMH has the "help plan" to assist patients who require medical attention but qualify under the Federal Poverty scale for reduced payments or "free care."

SMH will attempt to provide financial obligation information to patients well in advance of elective procedures so that arrangements can be made for higher copays or deductibles if they apply. In no case will emergent care be withheld pending copays or deductible payment.
