

Summersville Memorial Hospital Announces Nursing Scholarship

During the 17th Annual SMH Employee Recognition Dinner, Hospital CEO Deborah Hill announced the creation of a nursing scholarship fund in memory of Sherrell Walker, RN, a long time, dedicated, respected RN at SMH. Sherrell lost a courageous battle with cancer earlier this year, but her memory and legacy will live on in her family, coworkers and patients she touched.

Sherrell's husband and daughter were in attendance for the announcement. SMH donated \$1,000.00 to kick off the scholarship fund. The first scholarship will be granted in 2009 to a Nicholas County graduating senior entering an RN program.

The scholarship winner will receive \$500 per semester for up to 8 semesters, as long as they are actively enrolled in an approved registered nurse program, maintain a 3.0 average and submit a copy of their grades at the end of each semester. As the scholarship fund grows, SMH will consider increasing the dollar amount of the award or the number of annual recipients.
